College Class Responsibilities and Dual Credit Student Approval Form

I am requesting to enroll in dual credit classes through Brazosport College. I understand that college level classes will require a different level of effort and self-discipline. Students requesting registration in dual credit college courses, rather than high school courses, must commit to that schedule. Space in the high school classroom may be limited. My high school counselor has approved my request to apply for dual credit college classes.

To insure success in a college class, I understand the following:

- I understand that some essays and projects will be completed outside of class.

- I have met all the high school requirements to apply for college classes.
