- If you need transportation for hurricane season dial 2-1-1 to register for a ride.
- If you are driving yourself out of town during a hurricane, you can call 1-800-452-9292 for road side assistance on state highways for road conditions or courtesy vehicles. And of course if you have an emergency, dial 9-1-1.
- Some things you might want to take with you while evacuating, is family photos, jewelry, and items such as water, dry snacks, change of clothes, important documents, medications and credit cards.
