<p>As a student, you will need to put in your "Email address" as FirstInitialLastNameLast4DigitsOfYourStudentID@brazosport.edu.</p> <p>Teachers will use FirstName.LastName@brazosport.edu</p> <p>The "Server" will be webmail.brazosport.edu.</p> <p>The "Account Name" may be whatever has meaning to you.</p>	
<p>Our system needs the "Use secure connection" and "Verify Certificate" checked.</p> <p>The number of days for "Sync messages for:" is your personal preference.</p>

<p>Follow the instructions for set up to match this information, using your name.</p>	
<p>Then reboot your phone. Hold the Menu BUTTON (round center bottom) and the Power BUTTON (top right corner) together for a few seconds and the phone will give you an option to turn it off. Do so, then after it has shut down all the way turn it back on by pressing the Power BUTTON again. Give the phone a few minutes and see if the email starts coming in.
