The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, is a federal law that establishes the rights of students with regard to education records, and ensures students of the right to privacy and confidentiality with respect to those records. This form is provided as a means for students to give Brazosport College permission to discuss and/or disclose their academic records with someone other than themselves (i.e., with a parent, guardian, etc.). **A student wishing to revoke authorization for an authorized designee must complete and submit this form in person with a valid photo ID to the Office of Admissions & Registrar for each authorized designee.**
