Brazosport College supports the \$1.8 billion formula funding request that was outlined in the letter from the Texas Association of Community Colleges on July 27, 2018. In addition, we request credit hour funding for the Brazosport College Bachelor of Applied Technology degree programs. Formula funding for these upper division courses is calculated on the same basis as upper division courses at the general academic institutions.

With this level of funding from the State of Texas, Brazosport College will make the following investments:

- Expand skilled workforce training to support industrial expansion
- Recruit and retain faculty in high demand fields
- Implement intrusive advising system to improve student goal completion
- Implement guided pathways model to align curriculum with high schools and universities
- Enhance security measure to better safeguard students and college community

Brazosport College is committed to the goals set forth in 60X30TX and to serving a key role in economic development for the state of Texas and the Gulf Coast region. As a major provider for workforce training, we are the linchpin to success for major manufacturing industries with planned and announced expansions. Additionally, we are providing pathways for students to education goal completion as well as jobs and career with high labor market outcomes. As such, the College is investing in a robust and intrusive advising system to support goal completion and empower students to use these same skills for career advancement throughout their professional lives. Finally, the College is enhancing its security plans and establishing a campus police force as we prepare for the implementation of the new campus carry law, effective August 1, 2017.

Brazosport College submitted the Community College Petition: State-Funded Benefits requesting no reductions in HEGI, TRS, and ORP.

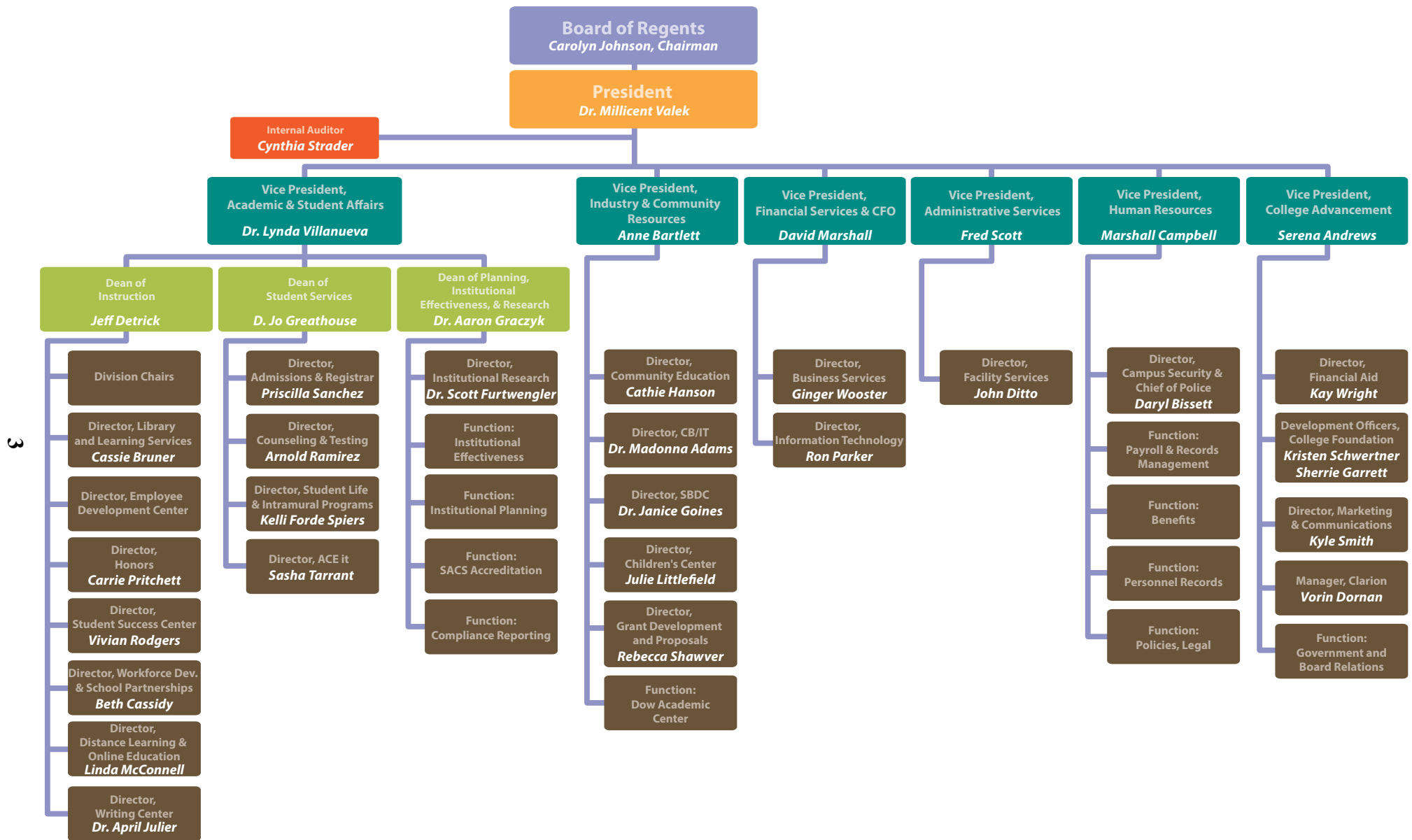
