Allied Health Track: Certified Nurse Aide to Patient Care Assistant/Technician

This program provides an opportunity for Certified Nurse Aides to earn a stacked credential and become a Patient Care Assistant/Technician (PCA/PCT). The student's CNA license must be current, in good standing, and license holder must have at least 1 year of working experience as a CNA during the last 3 years (before start date of the program). Under the supervision of medical and nursing staff, PCA/PCT provide basic care in hospitals, nursing homes, urgent care centers, wound care centers, home care agencies and long term care facilities to assist patients with activities of daily living. While PCA/PCT tasks may be similar to CNA tasks, additional higher level responsibilities such as performing EKG's and phlebotomy can also be expected from a PCA/PCT and will be taught in this program.
