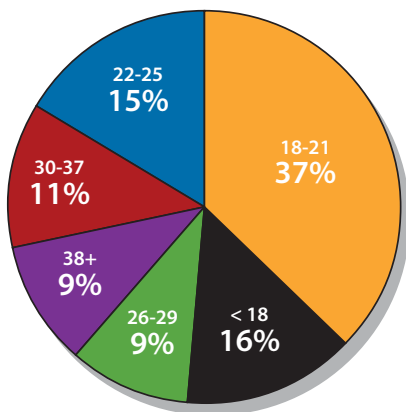

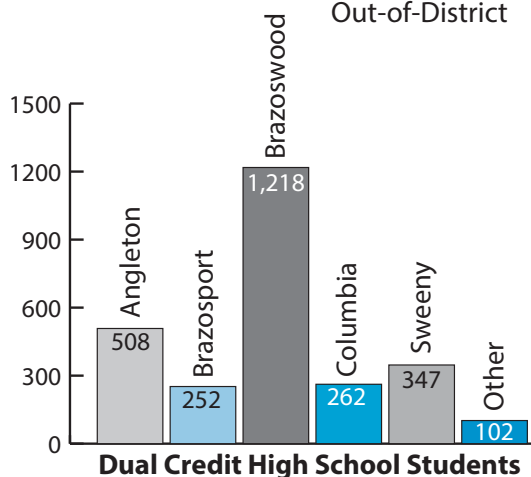

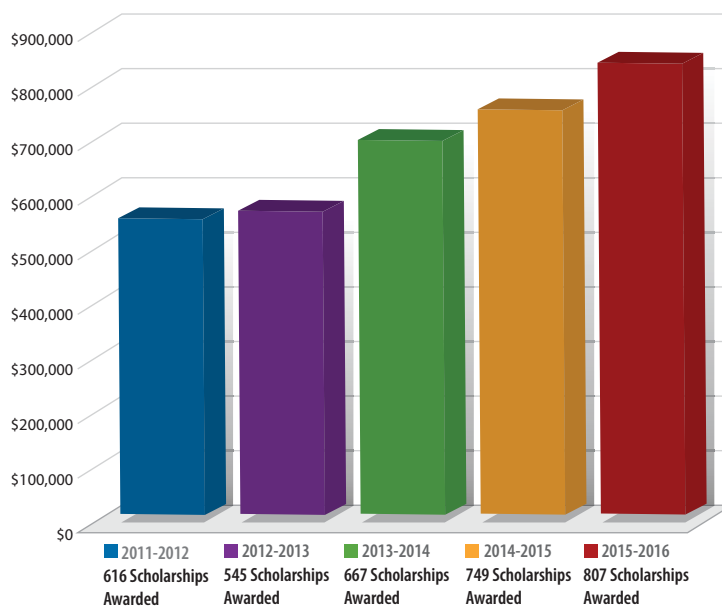
CBIT students are employed in business and industry and receive customized training through the college's Center for Business/ Industry Training.
